



# MasterCard SecureCode



Your First National Bank of Kansas MasterCard Debit Card has a security feature called SecureCode. SecureCode is designed to protect your card from unauthorized use online at certain merchants. With SecureCode, even if someone else knows your debit card number, they would be unable to complete a transaction while shopping online using your card at these merchants.

SecureCode is a **MANDATORY** security feature of your debit card. **You personally have to activate SecureCode.** You have two options for setting up your SecureCode:

- 1) Visit [www.shazam.net/SecureCode/](http://www.shazam.net/SecureCode/) and follow four easy steps. You will be asked to enter your debit card number and then you will be directed to another site to set up your SecureCode.
- 2) Activate During Shopping (ADS): While shopping at a participating merchant, after entering your debit card number, a SecureCode Activation page will pop up. You will be required to enter information to set up your SecureCode, then you will be returned to the merchant site to complete your transaction.
